

Volunteer Opportunities

Each family of a child in the play is required to:

1. Volunteer a minimum of 4 hours, OR
2. Pay a volunteer buyout fee of \$50
(cash or check made out to Lafayette PTA)

Rehearsal Volunteers

Snack Volunteer*	Provide snacks on rehearsal days. 2 rehearsals required. Not limited to your child's rehearsal. (You buy and bring the snack AND you need to be there to pass it out and help clean the hallway after snack. Typically it only takes 20 minutes: 1:45-2:05pm)
Rehearsal Volunteer*	Supervise children during rehearsal days. Must stay for the entire rehearsal. 4 rehearsals required.

* On the days we have snack volunteers, we will only have snacks at the first rehearsal slot 2-3 pm. There can be 2 snack volunteers for any day.

** There are two rehearsal slots for most days. 2-3 and 3-4. Each one is a different rehearsal for volunteer purposes, so you only need to stay for the duration of your rehearsal hour.

Pre-production Crew

Costume Volunteer	- Make costumes (Sew costumes using sewing machine or hand-sewing at home) -Do laundry before and after shows -Make K-1 Chorus T-shirts (NO sewing skills are required)
Set Building/Back Drop Painting	Meet several nights in March to help paint build sets and backdrop. No experience necessary.

Production Crew (TOTAL of 5 performances)

K-1 Chorus Wrangler	Help facilitate kids getting on stage, keep kids quiet when offstage. 2-3 performances required.
Large Group Wrangler (Mixed group grades 2-5)	Help facilitate kids getting on stage, keep kids quiet when offstage. 2-3 performances required.
Backstage Crowd Control	Assist Mrs. Welsh backstage during performance. 2-3 performances required.
Stage Hand/Backstage Prop Assistants	Help with the scene changes and the curtain. Manage the prop changes during performances. 2-3 performances required
Backstage Cue Runner	Liaison between the backstage and the actors. 2-3 performances required.
Backstage Dressers	Assist Lead backstage costumer with costume changes. 2-3 performances required.
Hair and Makeup	Help do performers hair and makeup before performance.
Sound Cues	During performances run the music and sound. All performances, tech rehearsals, and dress rehearsals required.
Lights	During performances run the lights. All performances, tech rehearsals, and dress rehearsals required.
